



2021 GIRLS CLUB – Terms & Conditions

The safety and well-being of the Girls and our instructors continues to be a priority for the Golfuture YYC junior golf programs. These guidelines are adapted from the AHS Covid-19 Information and Guidance for Day Camps and Businesses, and the NAGA-AB Golf protocols. Please read this document so that you know what to expect on the first day and so that we can run the program in the safest manner possible. We appreciate your help in protecting the health of all families involved and delivering a very positive experience to the junior golfers.

Steps Taken to Prevent the Risk of Covid-19 Transmission

Arriving Prepared

- Prior to starting the program, please talk to your child about physical distancing and respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene.
- Due to Covid-19 regulations, the portable washrooms have been removed from the South Academy, however, maintained washrooms are available at the Main Clubhouse. Should you feel this may be a concern, we ask that you remain onsite to assist with transporting your junior golfer to the Main Clubhouse.
- Each participant must bring their own water bottle. On the sunny days please ensure that your junior is protected from the sun by appropriate clothing and/or sunscreen.
- Parents wishing to stay and observe are welcome to do so only at the South Academy, but must bring their own lawn chair and maintain physical distancing protocols between participants and other parents. If lessons must occur at the Main Driving Range, due to capacity limitations, parents are asked to wait in the parking lot or off-site. This does not apply to the WHITE camps for ages 4-6.

Attendance and Screening

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each Junior Golf session. This information is collected in an effort to help AHS trace an outbreak if necessary.
- The AHS Covid-19 Self-Assessment checklist should be followed, including a temperature check, before bringing your child to each Junior Golf session. Should any of the symptoms on the list be displayed by a child during a session, parents will be contacted to come get the child and they will be removed from the activity and separated from other participants until the parent arrives.

Physical Distancing

- Participants and parents will not be permitted to leave their vehicles upon arrival until 5 minutes before the start of the session. This will also ensure that our staff can complete the cleaning procedures between sessions.
- Clubs will be provided to juniors who do not have their own. These clubs will be assigned to one junior only for the session, and will be disinfected before and after each session. Golfers must not share clubs or touch another participant's clubs. Craft supplies will be purchased for each participant to eliminate the need to share materials. Range stalls and flow areas will be marked and highly visible to protect 2-meter distancing between participants at all times.
- The 2-meter distance between an instructor and a participant will be maintained as much as possible. However, due to the nature of instruction and youth care, it may occasionally be compromised.

Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Training and crafting equipment such as golf clubs, range balls, hula hoops, scissors, glue, etc., will be cleaned and disinfected with approved materials before and after each session. A "wipe-twice" method will be used to clean and disinfect.
- Each golfer will have a name tag that will be discarded or disinfected after each session.

Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette

- Participants and parents are asked to please wash their hands before traveling to each Junior Golf session. There is no hand-washing station at the Academy end of the facility, so alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be used upon arrival and throughout the sessions.
- Please make every effort to follow proper respiratory etiquette while on the property. This includes coughing or sneezing in a bent elbow, promptly disposing of used tissues into a designated garbage bin, and using hand sanitizer after any coughs, sneezes, etc.

Non-Compliance

- If a child proves that they are incapable or unwilling to follow physical distance and/or hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette protocols, they will be removed from the activity and separated from the other participants. These occurrences will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

Weather Risks

- In the event of inclement weather, we will be sending email updates the day of.
